

GUIDE LEGO COLLECTIBLE MINIFIGURES SERIES 22

Series 22 has a wide variety of characters who don't share many elements beyond basic minifigure parts. Some large elements are easy to confuse, however, such as the dog and pony, or various hats. Shake the bag to get small elements to fall to the corners. 05, 08, and 10 have inner bags that will sound louder and more crinkly as you feel them.

This guide is intended to help novice hunters by highlighting the easiest and most unique elements. Experienced hunters will be able to use other elements to distinguish between characters.



01 Robot Repair Tech

Key element: Hammer

This bag is loaded with small elements, all of which can be used to ID. The hammer is the easiest with its long handle and prominent head.



02 Chili Costume Fan

Key element: Chili Costume

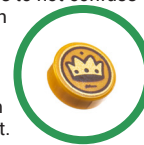
The huge Chili suit piece has a pointed tip and stem, and a huge cutout in the middle for the body.



03 Troubadour

Key element: 1x1 Round Tile (3x included)

With 3 included, the small coins should quickly shake to the corner of the bag. Make sure to not confuse them with the partially squared tiles from the Robot.



04 Snow Guardian

Key element: Round Shield with Handle

The large round shield has a smooth front and a distinct handle on the back. Confirm both to not confuse it with the wheelchair wheels or radar dish.



05 Horse and Groom

Key element: Carrot Stem (2x included)

Feel the distinct Y at the top of the stem. Don't confuse the stem with the Robot's hammer. Then find the pony to confirm.



06 Figure Skating Champion

Key element: Trophy

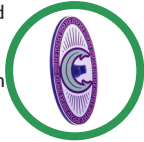
There are lots of small parts in this bag too, but find the trophy's distinct stem and wide, flat handles for a quick ID.



07 Night Protector

Key element: Oval Shield with Handle

Find the large, oval shield with a flat front and prominent handle on the back. Make sure the shield is oval and not round to distinguish from the Snow Guardian.



08 Forest Elf

Key element: 2x2 Radar Dish (2x included)

The small Radar Dish has a stud on top and an anti-stud ring on the bottom which can be felt in the bag. Alternatively find the Bar 3L for a quick ID.



09 Bird-watcher

Key element: Binoculars (2x included)

The small binoculars are a textured rectangle. You should feel the larger ends, and use a fingernail to feel the separate eyepieces.



10 Raccoon Costume Fan

Key element: Trash Can

The large 2x2x2 Trash Can is one of the larger pieces in Series 22. Feel for a large cylinder with very distinct handles.



11 Space Creature

Key elements: Laser Pistol and 1x1 Round Plate (2x)

The Laser Pistol's barrel rings should be easy to feel with your fingernail, or find either of the 1x1 round plates that should quickly shake to the corner of the bag.



12 Wheelchair Racer

Key element: Wheelchair Frame

The Wheelchair Frame is a very large, awkwardly shaped piece. Feel for the long front fork and the L-shaped seat between the axles.
